

Quechee Gorge Bridge Construction Update Eastbound Travel Lane Closure



Construction Update and Traffic Impacts

Workers had planned to close the eastbound travel lane of the Quechee Gorge Bridge during this past week of April 1, 2024. They were unable to do this because of the snowstorm. The eastbound lane will now be closed as early as Monday, April 8, 2024. The decision on which day during the week to implement the closure will be based upon weather conditions and how quickly the snow on the road melts.

Once the lane is closed, a concrete barrier will separate motorists from the work on the eastbound lane. Alternating travel over the bridge will be controlled by a traffic signal. New lines will be painted on the roadway. This closure is expected to remain in place through the end of the Fall 2024 construction season (October/November 2024).

For those traveling by foot, the trail is closed at the bridge underpass through the fall of 2025. The adjacent trail is open via a signed detour through the visitor center. Like last year, the contractor is using the southwest parking area as a staging site.
