

Quechee Gorge Bridge Construction Reminder of Travel Pattern Due to Lane Closure



Construction Reminder

Last month, workers closed the eastbound travel lane of the Quechee Gorge Bridge. With the closure, there are several features that have been implemented. They include:

- Eastbound lane closure;
- Alternating travel over the bridge, controlled by a traffic signal;
- Concrete barrier, to separate motorists from the workers; and
- New paint lines on the roadway.

These items will be in place through October / November of 2024.

For those traveling by foot, the trail is closed at the bridge underpass through the fall of 2025. The adjacent trail is open via a signed detour through the visitor center. Like last year, the contractor is using the southwest parking area as a staging site.
