Public Information Meeting Scheduled for Rutland-Southern Vermont Regional Airport Master Plan Update

Barre, Vt. — The Vermont Agency of Transportation has completed a draft of the Rutland-Southern Vermont Regional Airport's Master Plan Update (MPU) to account for changes that have taken place at the airport and in the aviation industry since the completion of the previous update in 2009. The master plan will be used to guide airport improvements to meet existing and future needs of airport users.

An informational meeting for the public to learn more about the master plan update will be held on Tuesday, September 21, from 7-8 p.m., at the Rutland Free Library Fox Meeting Room, 10 Court Street, Rutland. During the meeting, airport staff will explain the objectives of the study; review the study process, findings, and recommendations; and discuss the future of the airport.
